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1. Login into CPMS (Email + password+ sms)

2. Enroll a patient, use only the sections that best describe the patient

4. The CPMS coordinator will schedule a meeting and invite the experts to the meeting.

6. Assessment: attend the meeting, write a meeting summary and a case outcome, based on the recorded contributions (written or spoken) of the other panel members. After the meeting, set the status of the meeting to 'finished'.

7. Sign-off the outcome (the other panel members can view it and save it for own records); no personal data of the patient is visible
