DBS in Dystonia

Standard pathway for cross-site expert advice for management decisions in Dystonia patients.

It allows to receive individual recommendations concerning DBS, such as indication and/or target selection and/or treatment advice for transplanted patients, with the aim of optimizing patient care. (Restricted to European Union)



How do you receive cross-site expert advice concerning DBS (pre/post-OP) for a dystonia patient?



1. Contact CPMS helpdesk

They will propose a meeting date & support you with data upload in CPMS

2. Share data via CPMS

Enroll your patient in CPMS & upload MRIs. Add relevant clinical details.

Important: Upload all data > 2 weeks prior to meeting date



3. The experts view your case in CPMS

They will prepare for & attend the meeting.

Additional data may be required! CPMS helpdesk will be in touch with you.



4. Join the videocall

Additional colleagues can also join the call.

In the call, you will be asked to quickly present your case, bringing everyone on the same page. The experts will then ask questions and share their opinions.



5. Give feedback & close your case in CPMS
